

2025 SEEKONK SPEED POLICIES

MINOR POLICY

Any children who enter the pits must be at least 15 years of age or older and have minor release paperwork signed by BOTH parents in order to receive entry.

All paperwork must be signed and notarized PRIOR to arrival at the track. There are NO exceptions to this rule. This means there will be no babies, five-year-olds, 10-year-olds, etc., allowed. Only children ages 15-18 are allowed, with the minor paperwork signed and filled out. All patrons entering the pit area who are over 18 must be able to prove it if they are asked at the pit booth. Please understand this policy they have in place & plan accordingly.

Any children who enter the pits must be at least 15 years or older and have minor release paperwork signed by BOTH parents (print 2 forms, 1 for each parent to sign) along with a copy of the minor's Birth Certificate.

PET POLICY

There are no pets or dogs allowed in the pits at Seekonk Speedway. This includes in your haulers. Registered service animals only.

CAMPING POLICY

Camping is NOT allowed on the Speedway grounds per the Town of Seekonk

BAG & COOLER POLICY

To ensure a safe and enjoyable experience for all guests, Seekonk Speedway is implementing updated entry guidelines for the 2025 season in coordination with public safety outlines developed with the Town of Seekonk and Public Safety Officials.

Permitted Items

Each ticketed patron in the grandstands will be allowed to bring *one bag per person* that meets the following criteria:

- **Clear plastic bags or clear backpacks** measuring no larger than 12" x 6" x 12"
- **Small wristlets or handheld wallets**

Prohibited Items

The following items will *not* be allowed into the stadium:

- Bags not meeting the permitted criteria listed above
- Coolers, including those containing cans, glass bottles, or other beverages

- Wagons or Carts (Baby Strollers are Allowed)
- Drones
- Portable folding or standalone chairs (rest back chair backs are available for rent inside the stadium, personal seatbacks are allowed on Fast Fridays and NASCAR Weekly racing and must be less than 18" wide X 12" deep X 16" high)
- Dogs or pets (*service animals are permitted*)
- Umbrellas or pop-up tents
- Weapons of any kind (firearms, knives, etc.)

Special Considerations

Diaper bags and medical bags will be permitted but will be subject to inspection at designated entry points. If you are a member of a race team and have equipment we will make considerations subject to bag searches.

DIGITAL TICKET SALES

Through [SeekonkSpeedway.com](https://seekonkspeedway.com), fans can purchase grandstand admission passes online and put them into their Apple Wallet or print them at home, where they can use them to get in at the track on race day. The same goes for teams, drivers, and crew members in the pit area.

Pit passes are available in advance on the ticketing platform for purchase. The process is simple: patrons should go online to [SeekonkSpeedway.com](https://seekonkspeedway.com), click on tickets, and create an account through the software. Once the account has been created, purchase pit passes for the respective events you are going to be attending. Upon completing the purchase, a link will be sent to your email address with the passes. When opening the link, be sure to add them to your Apple Wallet or print them at home to bring with you on race day. This includes pit passes. They will then take their pre-paid pit pass to the booth, sign the waiver, and proceed into the pit area.

This also works for teams who would like to purchase passes for their entire team or a few crew members. Upon purchasing the passes, you are able to forward them to someone else's email address, and they will be able to access them for themselves.

This is especially important for Touring Series shows. Drivers and car owners can purchase passes for themselves and their crew and send them to the respective parties.

In order to purchase pit passes on race day for anyone other than just one person, all parties must be there at the time to sign and collect their pit passes. No lists will be created for crew members who are coming at a later time.
